Dear Burn professionals,

***Towards Global Leadership in Burn care***

The media is all agog that India is poised to take on a greater leadership role in fields ranging from contribution to global economy to climate change. While that is on the big stage, we also need to think as to how we can make India take on a leadership role in alleviation of suffering from Burn care. While we have made rapid strides in almost all the surgical specialties and sub specialties with centres and surgeons who could be compared with the best in the world, in burn care we have a long way to go. Long back a famous Hand Surgeon Richard Smith from Boston said, 'Today's patient must get the best that today has to offer'. This was irrespective of his place of living and affordability. If measured on that yardstick, we will be far behind. The reasons are many. They range from the number of surgeons who are really passionate about burn care to the economics of good burn care.

When there are too many constraints I think the best way to move forward is to look within and ask ourselves the question, 'Can we do something about this?'. May be not much. But all of us can do something about it. It is in the collective action of ours that progress can happen. It can start from providing a little extra care and spending a little extra time on a burn patient who is under our care right now, thinking hard to reduce the cost of care by following the principle of doing everything that is necessary and nothing that is unnecessary', speaking about the plight of burn patients, the cost of care, lost opportunities and preventable deaths to all those around us, in organizations like Rotary and Lions clubs, sensitizing the government officials .. and the list can go on. Each act of ours may not make a perceivable difference right now but over a period of time, the collective effort will make a difference.

Our current President Dr Anant Sinha has done a remarkable job by sensitizing the public, paramedics and the doctors on various aspects of burn care. He has travelled the length and breadth of the country. When he proposed the idea at the Coimbatore NABICON, many thought it would be a non starter. The collective efforts of all involved and an inspired leadership saw it though. I think each year if we do some concrete step we will reach the stage where India ought to be.

There is also another reason why we should become better. Acute burns occurs predominantly in South Asia and Africa and we need a successful model that works in the region. WE need to get the LD 50 scores closer to the best in the world. Then we really can take on a leadership position in burn care in the world. We are moving in the direction and have to consolidate the position. India has also produced surgeons like Dr Ahuja and DR Vinita Puri who have led international organizations and now it is time to produce organizations which will be the model for the world.

The last nation wide study on burns was "**The problems of burns in India**" by J W Davies published in Burns in 1990. A nation wide study to understand the burn scenario of the country had become imperative.

With rapid urbanization and changing domestic fuel scenario in the country, there was pressing need to know the disease burden status of burn, its prevalence and the economic consequence of it on victims.

Last year the Directorate of Health Services in one of its meetings communicated that there was a need to understand the burn scenario of the country. In response to this ten centers of the country were identified viz Delhi, Chandigarh, Jaipur, Mumbai, Nagpur, Chennai, Bhubaneswar, Imphal, Patna and Lucknow. 
This App based community survey conducted over the last one year was aimed to determine burn prevalence, Knowledge, Attitude and Practice (KAP) and Economic burden of burns. The study is funded by Indian Council of Medical Research. The result of this landmark study will be presented in the upcoming NABICON 2024 in Ranchi.

Another significant step has been taken by the department of Plastic Surgery, King George Medical University. The first dedicated one year certificate course on Burns has been started. This pioneering step has been taken by Prof. Dr. A. K. Singh and Dr. Vijay Kumar. With so many burn centers in the country it is time we recognize burns as a speciality and start courses to produce burn specialists.

It's also encouraging to see skin banks are opening all over the country. Recently skin banks have opened in Safdarjung Hospital and PGI Chandigarh.

And to end, on the behalf of the Academy I thank our President Dr. Anant Sinha for leading from the front by encouraging NABI members across the country to conduct workshops.

The passion of Burn Care is burning bright in India!

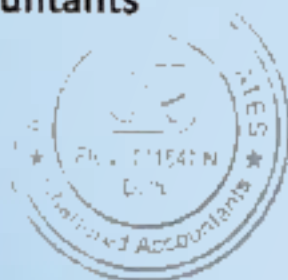



The CME saw a large number of participants from the nursing colleges from around the country and constituted both didactic lectures by eminent nursing faculty and skill workshops. The CME started with a virtual round of the venue, the National Burns Center . This was followed by inauguration programme and welcome address by Dr Sunil Keswani. The chief guest of the occasion was Ms Sneha Vaidya, the Nursing Director of Apollo Hospital, Kharghar, Navi Mumbai.

• NABI Mid Term CME was held at AIIMS, New Delhi on 18th & 19th January, 2023. It organised by Department of Plastic, Reconstructive and Burn Surgery, AIIMS, New Delhi. Dr. Maneesh Singhal, Professor and Head of the Department was the organizing chairman, Dr. Shashank Chauhan, the organizing secretary, Dr. Suvashis Dash, scientific coordinator and Dr. Shivangi Saha was the treasurer. It was held late this year due to technical issues with the bank account opening. It was a very well attended event. The theme of this CME was “**Policy and innovation in burn care**”. It was held in the new state of the art burn centre at AIIMS, New Delhi.

• Dr. Arun Bhatnagar, Head- Department of Plastic Surgery, Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal also organized a Burn CME for the benefit of PG students and local consultants. The meeting dealt with the advances in burn care and was also a great success. Many senior NABI members attended the meeting.

• E Certificate and membership cards are being given to all new members. Those who still haven't got the certificate can write to the secretariat.

• We had 42 new members this year. There were 43 applications, but due to the tragic demise of Dr Saurabh Sharma, we were left with 42 new members . It was decided that the money sent by Dr Saurabh Sharma was to be returned to his family members.

• The new members were welcomed and taken on rolls of the association.

• The NABI website was being updated with newsletter / notices.

• There was a proposal to host webinars etc on the website. It was suggested that the webinars videos will be posted on the youtube and the links will be posted on website.

• A new burn center was inaugurated in AIIMS, Bhubneshwar: The burn centre was inaugurated on 7th January 2023 by Hon'ble Union Minister Dr Manuskh Mandaviya, Minister of Health & Family Welfare and Chemicals & Fertilizers , Govt of India in the august presence of Hon'ble Union Minister Dr Dharmendra Pradhan, Minister of Education & Skill Development & Entrepreneurship , Hon'ble Union Minister of State, Dr Bharti Pravin Pawar, Minister of Health & Family Welfare and Smt. Aparajita Sarangi, Member of Parliament (LS) Bhubneshwar at AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The burn centre was funded by CSR initiative of NTPC. This Burns centre is a 36 bedded state of the art unit with modern amenities.

### 5. Treasurer Report – By Dr Peeyush K Thayal

• In the current financial year, the source of income for the association was through membership fee and interest from the savings accounts and FDs with IDBI, Canara bank and State bank of India.


More than 25 pgs across the country presented papers . 2 pgs got best paper awards. 2 pgs got for best poster presentation, one for best cartilage carving .

The Burn Centre is established in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar exclusively from the CSR Fund (19.87 Crs) by NTPC. The centre was inaugurated on 07<sup>th</sup> January 2023 by Dr Mansukh Mandaviya, Hon'ble Union Minister of Health & FW, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Hon'ble Union Minister of Education & Skill Development, Dr Bharti Pravin Pawar, Hon'ble Union Minister of State of Health & FW.



This Burns centre is a 36 bedded state of the art structure which is well specialized with modern amenities. It is well equipped with red zone, green zone, laser room, burn bath, Radiology and Pathology area on the ground floor. The first floor is exclusively a sterile zone with Two functional modular OT along with pre-op and post-op areas and 6 ICU beds. The second floor has 16 bedded ward, 6 cabins, 1 dressing room. The third floor has provision to accommodate social counselling room, dietician, physiotherapy, tele-conference seminar hall connecting all district hospitals of Odisha and all state hospitals of India. There will be a plan to expand this with a skin banking facility and Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy. 30 posts are created by the Ministry of health & FW, India for the patient care.

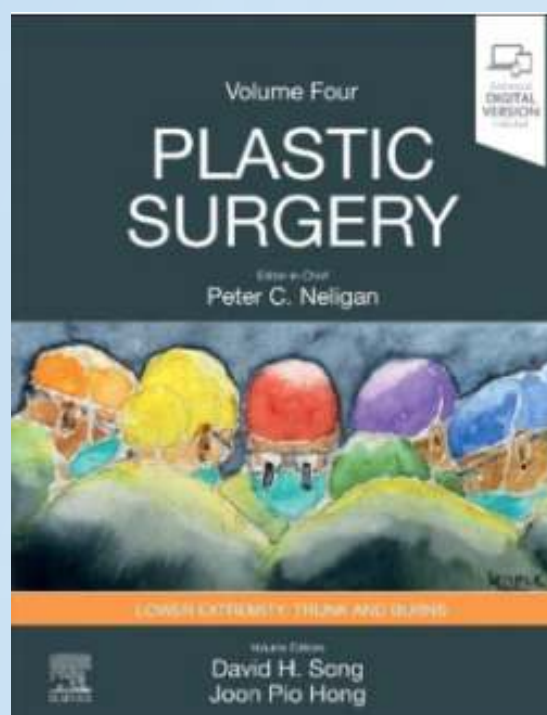

# जलना क्या है

जलना एक चोट या दुर्घटना है जो आग, गर्म तरल पदार्थ, बिजली, गर्म भाप, गर्म धुआँ, गर्म धातु, पटाखे व विस्फोटक सामान आदि कारणों से हो सकती है। जलने से चमड़ी, मांस पेशियां, कोशिकाएं, नसें इत्यादि भी क्षतिग्रस्त हो सकती हैं। जलने से गंभीर पीड़ा के अलावा शारीरिक विकृति, मानसिक एवं भावनात्मक परिणाम भी हो सकते हैं।

## जलने के कारण



**स्टोव-** आमतौर पर स्टोव फटने से व तेल लीक होने से आग लग सकती है।



**सिलेण्डर-** गैस पाइप के कटे-फटे होने और रेग्युलेटर के ठीक से फिट न होने के कारण गैस सिलेण्डर के फटने से आग लग सकती है।



**डिबरी-** खाली शीशी/डिब्बी में तेल और बत्ती डालकर घर में बनी डिबरी आग लगने का आम कारण है।



**गर्म तरल पदार्थ से जलना-** गर्म चाय/उबलता पानी/तेल/दूध/सूप आदि।



**गर्म भाप-** प्रेशर कुकर की भाप/बायलर से निकलने वाली भाप/भाप लेने वाली मशीन आदि।



**बिजली-** दोषपूर्ण तार, ढीले कनेक्शन/बिजली के खुले पाइंट या स्विच आदि।



**रसायनों के कारण-** रसायनिक कारखानों, विद्यालयों की प्रयोगशालाएं आदि।



**गर्म धातु-** प्रैस/कढ़ाई/पतीला आदि गलती से छूने पर त्वचा जल सकती है।



# जलने से बचाव - घर में

## स्टोव व गैस के चूल्हे का सही रख-रखाव



- हमेशा आई.एस.आई. मार्क वाले स्टोव/गैस चूल्हा प्रयोग करें।
- गैस सिलेण्डर को हमेशा सीधी स्थिति में खड़ा रखें।
- रबड़ की ट्यूब हर 3 से 4 माह में बदलें।
- ट्यूब का किनारा यदि खराब हो जाए तो उसे काट कर पुनः इस्तेमाल करें।
- गैस के चूल्हे का उपयोग नह हो तो रेगुलेटर बंद रखें।
- गैस के बर्नर की नियमित सफाई करें।

## रोशनी के स्थानीय उपकरणों का ध्यान रखें

कभी भी रोशनी के लिए खतरनाक उपकरणों जैसे दीया आदि का प्रयोग न करें क्योंकि इनसे आग लगने का खतरा रहता है।



हमेशा लैम्प, दीया, मोमबत्ती, लालटेन आदि को बच्चों की पहुँच से दूर, ऊँचाई पर रखें।

ज्वलनशील पदार्थ जैसे मिट्टी का तेल, माचिस इत्यादि जलते हुए लैम्प से दूर रखें।



नियमित रूप से लैम्प/लालटेन की सफाई एवं रख-रखाव करें।

हमेशा रोशनी करने वाले सभी उपकरण जैसे लैम्प, दीया आदि को पर्दों से दूर रखें।





## जलने से रहें सावधान

कभी भी ढीले-ढाले सिन्थेटिक कपड़े पहन कर खाना न बनाएं एवं चुन्नी/साड़ी के पल्लू को बांधकर ही काम करें।



बिजली के उपकरण जब प्रयोग में न हों तो तारों एवं प्लग को सॉकिट से निकाल कर स्विच को बंद कर दें।



जमीन पर बैठ कर खाना न बनायें हमेशा खाना बनाने का स्टोव प्लेटफार्म पर रख कर ही खाना बनाएं।

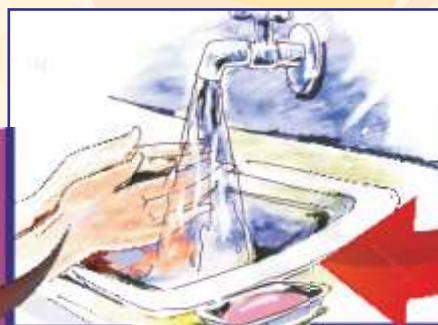

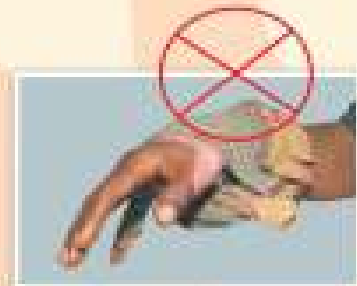

# BURN PREVENTION AT HOME

## Do's



- Always keep the cooking stove on a raised platform.
- Keep Matches/ Candles/ *Diya*/ Inflammables out of reach of children.
- Check temperature of the water for bath especially in case of children.
- Unplug all electrical gadgets when not in use and put off the switches.
- Use only ISI marked standard quality electric wires.

## Don'ts



- ❌ Do not wear synthetic, overhanging/ loose clothes while cooking.
- ❌ Do not let children play with electric gadgets matches, candles, lamps, fire etc.
- ❌ Do not hold a child while smoking/ drinking hot liquids
- ❌ Do not overload electric sockets.
- ❌ Do not smoke in bed.
- ❌ Do not throw a burning Bidi/ Cigarette anywhere.
- ❌ Do not sleep in the room with Electric Heaters/ Lamps, Candles on.

# BURN PREVENTION DURING FESTIVALS/ CEREMONIES

## Do's

- Light fireworks/ crackers only in open grounds/ outdoors.
- Buy good quality fireworks from authorized dealers only.
- Light only one firework at a time and watch from a safe distance.
- Keep 2 buckets of water and / or sand ready while igniting fireworks.
- Children should light fireworks only in the presence of elders.



## Don'ts



- ⊘ Never use fireworks inside the house.
- ⊘ Do not ignite fireworks while holding them in your hand.
- ⊘ Do not bend on an ignited firecracker.
- ⊘ Do not touch a misfired or half-burnt cracker.
- ⊘ Do not allow small children to handle fireworks/ cracker.
- ⊘ Do not burn fireworks while pointing at other people.
- ⊘ Do not light firecracker in narrow lanes.
